

112th Southern Amateur Championship

July 18-21, 2018

Entry Fee: Exempt = \$295; Sectional Qualifying = \$175 (Includes Qualifying Round Cart/Range Fee)

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to any male amateur golfer who has a current USGA Handicap Index[®] not exceeding <u>3.4</u> under the USGA Handicap System.

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

All players, <u>including those exempt</u>, must register online at <u>www.southerngolf.org</u>. Fax, mail-in, or telephone applications are not accepted.

- To submit an entry, visit <u>http://www.southerngolf.org</u> and click on "Southern Amateur>Register".
- An application for a player who is a minor upon the date of submission, in the state in which he resides (e.g., Alabama, under the age of 18) must be submitted by a parent/guardian, and list parent/guardian's name, phone number, and email address. The parent/guardian must agree to be bound by all terms and conditions on their behalf and on behalf of the minor player.
- All entries must be RECEIVED in the SGA office no later than 10:59pm CST on Wednesday, May 23, 2018. Entries will not be accepted after that time.
- An entry fee in the amount of \$295.00 for exempt players or \$175.00 for non-exempt players (see "Exemptions From Sectional Qualifying" section) payable by **credit card**, must accompany the entry application. For players who successfully qualify, the SGA will charge the credit card used to register for sectional qualifying the remaining championship entry fee balance of \$120.00.
- Upon successfully completing the entry procedure, an email confirmation will be automatically generated and sent to your email address.

The SGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.southerngolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration.

Entries are subject to rejection or withdraw at any time, including during the event, by the SGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in *The Rules of Golf*.

REFUND POLICY

Sectional Qualifying

Withdrawal: If an accepted player withdraws before **10:59pm CST on the day prior to his respective qualifying date** for any reason, the entry fee will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee. No refunds will be made after that time.

No Shows: Players that fail to notify the SGA of their withdrawal and "No Show" their starting time will not receive a refund for any reason. "No Show" players may be subject to suspension from future SGA events.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into the sectional qualifier.

Championship

Withdrawal: If an exempt player withdraws before 10:59pm CST on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 for any reason, the entry fee of \$295.00 will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee. No refunds will be made after that time. If a sectional qualifier withdraws before 10:59pm CST on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 for any reason, the championship entry fee balance of \$120.00 will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee. No refunds the championship entry fee balance of \$120.00 will be refunded, subject to a \$30.00 service fee. No refunds will be made after that time.

No Shows: Players that fail to notify the SGA of their withdrawal and "No Show" their starting time will not receive a refund for any reason. "No Show" players may be subject to suspension from future SGA events.

All dates and time refer to date and time of receipt at the SGA office.

SCHEDULE

Competition will be in two stages:

- 1. Sectional Qualifying 18 holes of stroke play for non-exempt players.
- 2. Championship 156 players, including exempt players and sectional qualifiers.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

- 72 holes of stroke play. The field will be cut to the low 66 players and ties after 36 holes.
- The lowest score for 72 holes will be the Champion.
- In the event of a tie for the Championship, a "sudden-death" hole-by-hole play-off will be held immediately following play. The play-off holes and their order of play will be determined by the Committee.
- Initial groupings will be for first two rounds; the field will be cut and grouped by score after the second round for the third round; grouped by score after third round for the fourth round.

EXEMPTIONS FROM SECTIONAL QUALIFYING

Players in the categories listed below are eligible from exemption from Sectional Qualifying in the 2018 Southern Amateur Championship. The SGA reserves the right to revise the exemption categories. Exempt players must have filed an entry and paid the entry fee by May 23, 2018. SGA will file a blank entry for any player becoming exempt after the registration deadline.

- A. Southern Amateur Champions in the last five years (2013-2017)
- B. Any player finishing in the top fifteen and ties in the 2017 Southern Amateur Championship
- C. 2017 & 2018 Southern Junior Champion
- D. Top 275 in SPWAR (Scratch Players World Amateur Rankings) as of March 12, 2018 (www.scratchplayers.org)
- E. Top 135 in WAGR (World Amateur Golf Ranking) as of March 12, 2018 (www.wagr.com)
- F. Top 10 in Rolex AJGA Rankings as of March 12, 2018
- G. Top 3 individuals (stroke play) from each 2018 Power 5 Conference Golf Championship (ACC, SEC, Big 10, Big 12, PAC 12)
- H. Medalist from each 2018 NCAA Division I Regional Golf Championship
- I. Top 5 individuals (stroke play) from the 2018 NCAA Division I Golf Championship
- J. 2018 NCAA Division II & III Individual Champion
- K. Any player extended a Bobby Jones Invitation by the Amateur Competition Committee

SECTIONAL QUALIFYING AND ALTERNATES

- Sectional qualifying is 18 holes of stroke play.
- The number of qualifiers' places at each site is determined by the SGA after entries close, based on the size of the field. Ties for the final qualifying position will be determined by sudden death playoff immediately following the conclusion of play. Alternates will be ordered by the scores at each qualifying site using the USGA recommended score card playoff procedure to break ties (last 9 (Holes 10-18), last 6 (Holes 13-18), last 3 (Holes 16-18), 18th hole, 1st hole, 2nd hole, etc. until the tie is broken).
- If a Sectional Qualifying location cannot fill its qualifiers' places, or if an exempt player withdraws, the open spot will be re-allotted to another qualifying site location pre-determined by the SGA.
- Qualifying site assignment is based on the date/time the SGA receives and processes each entry form. Qualifying site assignments cannot be changed after entries close.
- If a qualifying site is full at the time of registration, a player may opt to be placed on that site's alternate wait list or register at another qualifying site. A player may only register for one qualifying site.
- Wait list alternates and on-site alternates are ranked according to date/time an entry is received and processed. Qualifying site player information is sent after entries are accepted.
- *Note: Qualifying sites may be cancelled due to a lack of participation.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Monday, July 16

Tee times available for practice.

Tuesday, July 17

Player Registration. Tee times available for practice.

Wednesday, July 18

First round of stroke play. Hosted lunch for championship contestants.

Thursday, July 19

Second round of stroke play. Hosted lunch for championship contestants.

Field cut to low 66 scores and ties.

Friday, July 20

Third round of stroke play. Hosted lunch for championship contestants.

Saturday, July 21

Final round of stroke play. Hosted lunch for championship contestants.

CART/RANGE FEES

- Sectional Qualifying: Sectional qualifying cart/range fees paid by the SGA and included in the entry fee. Competitors have the option to either walk or use a golf cart during qualifying rounds (Greensboro, West Point, and Cordova qualifying sites are mandatory carts). Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds payable at the host club.
- *Championship Site:* Championship site practice and championship round range fees paid by the SGA.

HOSTED LUNCH

• Hosted lunch is provided by the SGA to championship contestants each day of the championship.

TRANSPORTATION; PUSH/PULL CARTS

- Competitors and caddies must walk during championship rounds. Optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of *The Rules of Golf* will be in effect. See "Golf Cart Requests" section below for disabled golf cart requests.
- Push/Pull carts are allowed.

CADDIES; SPECTATORS; GOLF CART REQUESTS

- *Caddies:* Caddies are allowed for sectional qualifying and championship rounds. Caddies will not be available at host club.
- Sectional Qualifying Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time.
- Caddies are required to wear an SGA issued caddie bib at the championship proper. Bibs will be available at the designated starting tee and must be returned to the SGA at the conclusion of each round.
- *Spectators:* SGA welcomes spectators at our championships. For your safety, we request that spectators walk near the cart path at all times.
- Disabled Golf Cart Policy: In consistency with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), SGA will grant an individual with a bona fide disability a golf cart if the following conditions are met:
 - 1. Requesting individual completes and submits a Disabled Golf Cart Request Form by the close of entries;
 - 2. Host club has a golf cart available;
 - 3. Requesting individual pays host club the appropriate cart fee;
 - 4. Requesting individual presents to the SGA staff or SGA representative a handicap card issued by a government agency.

PRIZES

- Sectional Qualifying: Lowest Score at each qualifying site: Silver medal. If a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded.
- Championship: An award will be presented to the three lowest scores after 72 holes. Champion will have his name engraved on the George W. Adair Trophy, which is enshrined in the Bob Jones Room of the Atlanta Athletic Club, Atlanta, Georgia.

EXEMPTIONS EARNED

- Champion receives a five year exemption in the Southern Amateur Championship (2019-2023).
- Players finishing in the top 15 (and ties) receive an exemption into the 2019 Southern Amateur Championship.

RULES OF GOLF

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and Conditions of Competition are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The SGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying.

CLOSE OF COMPETITION

The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented.

SPECIAL REQUESTS

Special requests for starting times or pairings may not be granted.
